

AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

PATUCK-GALA COLLEGE OF COMMERCE & MANAGEMENT

AND

SUJAYA FOUNDATION

This Agreement is made and entered into at Mumbai on August 1, in the year 2017, between:

- Patuck-Gala College of Commerce & Management,
 registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950, under Registration No. E-619
- 2. **Sujaya Foundation**, established in 2002, registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950, under Registration No. **E-20244** (hereinafter referred to as "SF", which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns), having its office at 401-A Lotus House, New Marine Lines, Mumbai 400 020 Each of Patuck-Gala and SF shall be individually referred to as the "**Party**" and both Patuck-Gala and SF are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "**Parties**".

WHEREAS:

Patuck-Gala College an educational institution

(A) SF has been engaged in providing education to the under-privileged youth by incorporating the best pedagogical practices at an Elementary as well as an Advanced



Level and attempts to bridge the gap for its students between education and employment.

(B) Patuck Gala and SF have agreed to collaborate with each other in undertaking and managing the Program and have therefore arrived at an agreement as appearing hereinafter.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:-

1. PROGRAM - Patuck-Sujaya English Immersion Program

The Program proposed – Patuck-Sujaya English Immersion Program to be undertaken jointly by Patuck-Gala and SF is for providing English Communication exposure with an aim to equip the youth to have better employable skills. The Program will be jointly undertaken by the Parties at Patuck-Gala College premises at Patuck Campus, 100 Nehru Road, Rustomba Patuck Marg, Near Vakola Bridge, Vakola, Santacruz (East), Mumbai, 400 055.

The term of this Program shall be for a period of 3 (three) months from August 2017 up to November 2017. Based on the success and mutual interest of both the parties the program can be extended.

2. GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- (i) Patuck Gala College will provide one classroom to conduct the classes.
- (ii) SF will deploy its own specialized staff for training the students.
- (iii) SF will also provide the salary of the deployed staff

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- (iv) SF will charge students a nominal amount of fees of INR 600 for an overall period of 3 months. The objective is to encourage co-payment to instill a sense of responsibility among students
- (v) Furthermore, SF will share 50 % of the revenue earned through the fees collected from students, with Patuck-Gala College
- (vi) The program will cater to the First Year, Second Year and Third Year students.
- (vii) SF will not pay any rent and electricity for the premises used.

3. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

The Parties here to agree that the roles and responsibilities of each of the Parties in relation to the Program shall be as under:-

(i) Patuck Gala College

- a) It shall provide adequate space for conducting classes.
- b) It shall be responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the said premises.
- c) It shall ensure security of these rooms at all times.
- d) It will not make any cost recoveries from SF for activities listed above (these include maintenance and others)

(ii) SF

- (a) It shall provide skill building sessions in terms of English Communication.
- (b) It shall disseminate the information of the program to the students.
- (c) It shall provide the managerial expertise and staff for setting up the training program. It will be responsible for the smooth running of the program.
- (d) It shall provide the syllabus and pedagogy for the course to be conducted. These will remain the property of SF.

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- (e) It shall conduct two hours sessions for four days a week: Monday to Thursday.
- (f) SF can charge students with nominal amount as fees, which is disclosed to Patuck Gala College.

4. COOPERATION

On the signing of this Agreement, the Parties shall cooperate in respect of the Program in the following manner to ensure successful fulfillment of the Program:

- (a) On going co-operation from both Patuck-Gala staff and SF staff
- (b) Communications and notices between Parties shall be sent to the following parties:

If however such dispute or difference is not settled within 30 days of the first mutual meeting for settlement and there have been at least four such meetings during that period, then if such dispute/difference is still not resolved the Agreement between the Parties hereto as contained herein shall come to an end and thereupon neither Party shall have any claim against one another.
