MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON EXCHANGE OF FACULTY MEMBERS

BETWEEN

ST. JOSEPH COLLEGE OF ARTS & COMMERCE, VIRAR (W)

AND

**PATUCK-GALA COLLEGE OF COMMERCE &
MANAGEMENT, SANTACRUZ (E)**



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This Agreement is made and entered into at Patuck College on 5th / 10 / 2018 in the year 2018 between:

St. Joseph College of Arts & Commerce, Satpala, Rajodi Road, P.O. Agashi, Virar (W), Tal. Vasai, Palghar – 401 301 And

Patuck-Gala College of Commerce & Management, Patuck Campus, Rustomba Patuck Marg, Near Vakola Bridge, Santacruz (E), Mumbai – 400 055 registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950, under Registration No. E-619 (B)

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

Preamble

Whereas, Patuck-Gala College and St. Joseph College have many areas of common interest in the faculty of Commerce, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academic, education and research.

Now therefore, Patuck-Gala College and St. Joseph College have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two Institutions.

Clause 1: Object

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two Institutions shall seek to promote any of the below:



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Faculty Exchange

- i. The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of both institutions
- ii. Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest
- iii. The exchange of academic materials and publications
- iv. Conducting lectures
- v. Undertaking joint research
- vi. Idea sharing sessions for the purpose of curriculum development and review and also upgrading of teaching and research skills
- vii. Participating and conduct of seminars, symposiums and other types of academic discussions
- viii. Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration which will be agreed upon mutually. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including those concerning remuneration, travel funding, and housing will be worked out between the Institutes.

Clause 2: Agreement

Patuck-Gala College and St. Joseph College agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two Institutes.

These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

Clause 3: Co-ordination

A Coordination Committee consisting of a Programme Coordinator from the side of Patuck-Gala College, and a Programme Coordinator from the side of St. Joseph College will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen co-operation between the two Institutes.

Clause 4: Validity

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of Two years commencing from the effective above mentioned date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.



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Clause 5: Termination

Either Institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of two months in advance to the other Institute. Once terminated, neither Patuck-Gala College nor St. Joseph College will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutes may suffer. However, Patuck-Gala College and St. Joseph College will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

Clause 6: Amendments / Modifications

This MoU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both Institutes.

Clause 7: Adherence To Rules

An Exchange Program Committee maybe setup at each end and the composition maybe decided as per the discretion of the respective Institutes.

Participating faculty members and staff involved in any activities under this Memorandum must adhere to the rules and regulations of the Institutes.

Clause 8: Legal Right

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the Institutes. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial academic collaboration.

Clause 9: Dispute Resolution

In case, there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic co-operation, Heads of Institutes, namely, Patuck-Gala College and St. Joseph College will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.



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Patuck-Gala College and St. Joseph College welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for co-operation and jointly agree to the provisions as set out above.
