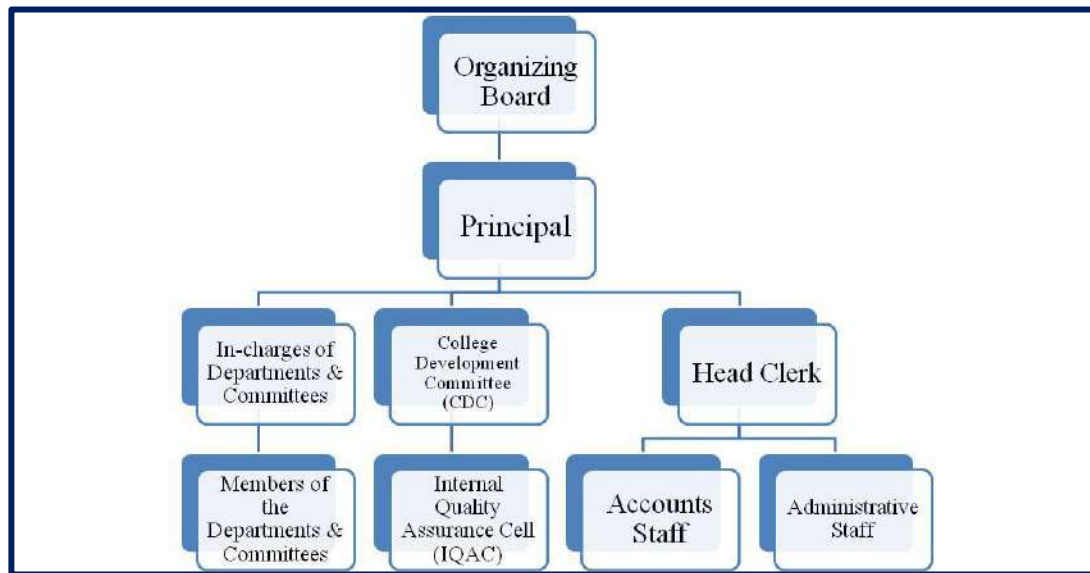

Departmental Activities

Accountancy

The Department conducted the below given activities:

Knowledge Dissemination

- A Guidance lecture on professional courses was conducted by Ranjeet Rao, the faculty member of the Department, on June 10, 2020, through Google Meet. A total of 24 participants attended the lecture. Various courses and career options available after graduation were discussed with the participants and they became familiar with different options available.
- A Webinar on ‘Uses of Tally ERP-9 in Filing GST & Audits’, was organized on July 2, 2020, through the Zoom platform. The Webinar received an overwhelming response from 120 students. The Key speaker at the Webinar was Ranjeet Rao, the faculty member of the Department. The Webinar aimed at making students equipped with the process of uploading each invoice on the GST portal and at the same time it also focused on capturing the right details and uploading them without any errors and mismatch. The Webinar was an enriching experience. E-certificates were awarded to all the participants.
- The Department in association with Board of Industry-Academia Partnership (BIAP) organized a “Webinar on Financial Wellness Programme” on August 15, 2020, through Google Meet. The Webinar was aimed at providing financial literacy and also on how to achieve financial freedom by proper planning and utilizing various tools of investment. The Webinar focused on eradicating certain misconceptions in the minds of students with reference to various financial tools, their planning and implementation. The programme was attended by 75 students. BIAP organizes programmes on behalf of institutions like the NSE and SEBI. Mr. Rahul Mahajan, Faculty, HR College of Commerce, Mumbai, was the resource person of the Webinar. E-certificates were awarded to participants.

Co-curriculars

- The Department organized an Inter-Collegiate Quiz Competition based on Accounting Terminologies on August 15, 2020. The main objective of this competition was to evaluate the accounting knowledge of the students. The Competition was conducted through Google Forms. A total of 138 participants responded from different Institutions across the Country. E-certificate was awarded to all the participants who qualified the quiz.
- “Expression of Thought” was conducted in association with the NDLI Club of the Library, on September 27, 2020, through Google Meet. 10 students participated in the event. Megha Nair and Ranjeet Rao were the judges for the event. The activity was aimed at utilizing National Digital Library E-resources and also spreading awareness among the students on how the Library Resources can be utilized during this on-going pandemic. The participants went through the library and its resources - they selected books, Journals, prepared notes for themselves and fully equipped themselves to express their thoughts in the competition. E-certificate was given to participants.
- An Intra-Collegiate Quiz Competition was organized on September 28, 2020, based on articles that appeared in the Accounting Times which is a monthly magazine and regularly uploaded onto the College Website. Similarly, a quiz based on articles of Accounting Times uploaded in the second semester of the year, was conducted on April 8, 2021. The quiz was aimed at developing the habit of reading among the students. The event received participation from 65 students in the first term and 35 students in the second term. E-certificate was issued to participants who qualified the quiz.

Banking & Insurance

The Department of Banking & Insurance conducted many activities in the Academic Year. The activities were conducted on the online platform as the College was closed due to lockdown.

- On July 28, 2020, PowerPoint Competition was conducted where the students had participated in large number in Google meet and showcased their power point presentation. Such activity is initiated by the Department to encourage students which allows them to exhibit their creativity in presentation.
- On August 12, 2020, a Crossword and Tagline competition was conducted. The activity was conducted by Megha Nair and supervised by the Course Co-ordinator Byshi Panikar.
- On October 2, 2020, an online Guest lecture on ‘International Trade and Finance Remittance’, was organized by Karim Khan, Alumnus, was the speaker. He is currently working as a Senior Analyst in Barclays Bank. He provided deep insights on the subject of share market and derivative market, and he also briefed the students about how financial institutions actually work and what are the processes followed in the Bank. The lecture gave practical insights about the banking sector.
- On February 28, 2021, an Online Business Quiz was conducted. It was done through a Google Form.
- On March 22, 2021, a Slogan Making competition was conducted by the Department. Students who were interested mailed their slogan to their Course Co-ordinator. Such activities encourage students to think independently and have creative ideas.

Business Communication

The students have had the exposure to learn and practice communication skills with amalgamation of soft skill development through the activities conducted.

- On January 29, 2020, the Department conducted an open themed Elocution competition. This was done in order to allow a flow of creative ideas from students. Students spoke on topics like social change, personality development, conflict management, career development, etc.
- On February 11, 2020, was conducted an activity titled, ‘A Sportive Activity: It’s Impact on Communication’. Here, students were instructed with regards to different movements like standing, sitting, jumping, running, etc. This activity was specifically done in order to gauge students’ listening and comprehending skills.
- On March 5, 2020 the Department conducted a Poetry Writing Competition. Since the theme was an open one, poetries on a wide array of themes were received, like nature, happiness, butterflies, etc.
- On May 29, 2020 the Department conducted a Short Story Writing Competition. The theme was an open one. Since it was during the period of lockdown, we received a number of stories based on the lockdown. A few others also wrote on other creative topics of their choice.
- The Department in collaboration with Library Committee (NDLI) organized an online activity on “Reading, Writing & Narrating Skills” on December 24, 2020. The activity was organized to provide an opportunity and enhance the skills of the student’s reading, writing and narrating skills. It was to help the students to learn the importance

of reading in this digital world and inculcation in their personality. It was conducted in three languages English, Hindi and Marathi so that student could perform their best.

- An Online Activity on Soft Skill competition was organized on January 25, 2021. It was to help the students to learn the importance of soft skill inculcation in the personality traits and learn to overcome the modern challenges through effective communication.
- The Department conducted a Video Making Competition on Introduce Yourself from February 2-9, 2021. This activity was conducted to build up the confidence among the students so as to express their minds through the use of technology and improve their knowledge and personality.
- An Online Audio-Visual Quiz competition was conducted on April 1, 2021. 57 students participated in the competition. All the winners were given E-certificates.

Business Economics

Several intra and inter collegiate activities were conducted through the Academic Year:

- Call the Bluff Competition was organized on July 30, 2020, and in it 83 students participated.
- Biz Map - Business strategy competition was organized on August 17, 2020, and 27 students participated in the same.
- The Department in association with the NDLI Club of the Library organized a Panel Discussion on 'Foreign Investment in India –Why is it so Important for a Country like India' on October 2, 2020, through the Google meet. In the Panel Discussion 6 student speaker (Panelist) actively participated, and 40 students participated as audience. The best speaker among the panelist and the best audience asked question was judged by Megha Nair. The other student panelists were also awarded Certificate of Participation
- An Essay writing competition for students in the month of October 2020, was conducted on the topic, 'Sectors worst hit during the Covid-19 Pandemic' and 'Sectors most benefitted during the Covid-19 Pandemic'. From the 7 participants, one was selected as the best entry.
- In the Second term a Quiz was organized for students on April 16, 2021. It was based on the Union Budget and was through a Google Form. In all 54 participations were received.
- An Essay writing competition for students on April 17, 2021, was organized. The topics were: a) Impact of lockdown in Indian Economy b) Migration of Labour during Lockdown in India and c) Educated Unemployment during Lockdown In India. 10 entries were received.

Inter-Collegiate Event

Each Academic year, during the Second term, the Department conducts "Arthlekhan – the Inter-collegiate Essay writing Competition" for the academic fraternity. This year the essay writing competition was for the students. The College received 10 entries on the following themes:

- Indian Economic Growth since the pandemic
- Employment Scenario in India Post COVID
- Indian Rural Recovery Post COVID: A Possibility
- Measures for Revival of the Indian Economy Since COVID

The essays were scrutinized by experts in Business Economics and the winners were declared by them.

Business Law

Business Law as a subject teaches the students the corporate law and laws binding businesses. In order to enhance this knowledge, co-curricular activities as listed below, were organized.

- On May 22, 2020, an Essay writing competition for all the students was conducted, on the topic, “Violation of Human Rights during Covid-19 pandemic”. 9 students participated in the competition and explained their views through the essay. The entries were judged on the basic criteria of idea presentation.
- On July 28, 2020, the Department organized an Online Quiz competition via Testmoz. Around 68 students participated in the Quiz. The topic for the Quiz was “Essential Elements of a Valid Contract” The aim was to understand how much students have understood about the topic. This activity was conducted during the ongoing lecture.
- On December 6, 2020, the Department organized an Online movie screening and Quiz competition on “Constitution of India”. About 73 students participated in the same. Movie screening was conducted via YouTube link and Quiz was conducted via Google form.
- On April 14, 2021, the Department organized a Quiz competition on the eve of Mahamanav Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Jayanti. About 111 Participated in the quiz. Winners were appreciated with certificates.

Commerce

The Department organised co-curricular activities through the Academic Year through the online platform and they received their outcomes and also a good response.

- An essay-writing competition themed ‘Buying Behavior of Consumers during COVID-19’ was organized on June 10, 2020.
- The Department conducted a Motivational Quote Writing Competition on July 25, 2020, where participants made a poster of motivational quotes by CEOs which are meaningful and have had a positive effect on them. The competition was a rather creative and competitive one.
- The Department conducted a Business Plan Competition on August 25, 2020, for students of all sections. The event was conducted to encourage students to understand what all goes into making a business plan.
- A competition on ‘Marketing Strategies to Promote Business A Plan’ was conducted on September 29, 2020. The activity was conducted to encourage students to understand the different ways of promoting a business.
- A PowerPoint presentation Competition in association with the NDLI Club of the Library was conducted on October 20, 2020. The competition made students feel the importance of e-resources in the days of the pandemic.
- The Department on January 28, 2021, conducted an online Ad-making competition. The students were required to prepare a poster advertisement and come up with an innovative brand name. This activity was done to encourage creativity in the students and have a hands-on experiential activity of learning to create advertisements. The 12

students who participated, got acquainted with the ad-making process and came up with innovative posters.

- On March 28, 2021, the Department organized a Product Development Competition. This competition was open to students of all sections. The contest was conducted to develop creativity within our students to develop and launch new products which are not yet available in the market and also to instil the concept of product design and development in the minds of students.

Computers

The year had been an eventful year for the Department in terms of co-curricular activities.

- The first activity of the year was a Contest on “Patuck Power Point Presentation 2020-21”. It was held on July 30, 2020. Students were asked to submit their PPT through their official email id. 9 students participated.
- The second activity of the year was a Training session on “*Google Workspace, formerly known as G Suite*”. It was held on October 31, 2020. The lecture was given by Ms. Prajakta Joshi, Faculty member, L. S. Raheja College of Arts & Commerce. The lecture covered various aspects of helping students to use Google and its various applications. There were 16 students from S.Y.BMS- S.Y B.Com. (B&I) classes who attended the same.
- The third activity of the year was a guest lecture on the topic “*Telecom Revolution*” and was held on January 28, 2021. The lecture was given by Mr. Shekhar Pawar, Jt. Director, DVP Infra Projects Pvt. Ltd, Mumbai. The lecture covered various aspects of helping students to understand *Telecom Industry & Product line*. There were 9 students from S.Y.BMS- S.Y B.Com. (B&I) classes attended the same.
- The fourth activity of the year was an Online Webinar on “Microsoft Office 365 Skills for Workplace -platform to drive productivity at workplace)” and it was held on April 2, 2021. The lecture was given by Mr. Prashant Kokane. The lecture covered various aspects of Office 365 product and its features to understand the importance in workplace environment which is very much necessary in current corporate world in India. 71 students, 2 Teachers, 1 non-teaching staff and the Librarian attended the webinar.

Counselling & Guidance Cell

- Paper to Heart -A Session on Journaling
A session on Journalling was organized on July 28, 2020 for students on Google Meet. Monisha D’costa had conducted the session where 24 students attended the session to learn about Reflective Journaling and Gratitude Journaling. The session boosted the confidence and morale of the students, and brought them the realization of the power of gratitude.
- Article-writing Competition on Self-help
The Cell on August 31, 2020, organized an activity on Article-writing on the topics mentioned below:

- Panel Discussion on “Media and Mental Health @ L.S. Raheja College
10 students from our College attended the Panel Discussion on Media and Mental Health on Zoom Platform organized by L. S. Raheja College on October 10, 2020. The session helped the students to understand and handle their stress, overcome their own negative thinking and use social media for positive purposes and make their own choices rather than just thoughtlessly follow others
- Heart- to-Heart: Open Thought Sharing Session
The Cell on October 26, 2020, organized an Open Thought sharing Session on the topic “Effects of Media Consumption on the Mind” on 26th October, 2020 on Google meet. The session was conducted by Monisha D’Costa and 63 students attended the session to identify how media has a role to play in their thought process. While they did acknowledge the positive effects of media, they also realized how media negatively affects them, through this reflective session. Therefore, the overall outcome was that these session created more consciousness among students with regards to consumption of media
- Orientation Program for First Year Students
Sunita Bhuiya, Convenor of the Cell, on October 30, 2020, conducted the Orientation Program for First Year students of B.Com, BMS & B.Com.(B&I) on Google Meet. 68 students had attended the program to understand the facilities available for personal and academic counselling to the students of the College where a Professional Counsellor is available for the same. The students were assured of confidentiality in regards to their problem sharing
- Online Session on “Family Mental Health During COVID-19”
The Cell in association with the Parent Teacher Association organized the Online session on “Family Mental Health During COVID-19” for parents on January 24, 2021, where 46 parents participated for the session. Ms. Paulomi Pandit, the Counsellor of the College conducted the session to explain the parents on:

 The session helped the parents to understand the concept of mental health and the necessity of self-care to change their lifestyle
- Online Story Telling Competition on “Gender Empowerment”

The Cell in collaboration with Women Development Cell organized an Online Story Telling Competition on “Gender Empowerment” on February 8, 2021. Five students participated in the Competition to spread awareness among the students about Gender Equality and to encourage and motivate them to be self-empowered and socially responsible. - Online Session on Study Management and Exam Tips During Lockdown

Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension

In the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic and the ensuing lockdown, the College received the circular from DLLE, University of Mumbai only in the first week of November 2020, instructing to commence enrollments for the DLLE program and permit enrollments till December 31, 2020.

The University Department conducted its First Term Orientation for extension Teachers, on November 9, 2020. Herein, were instructions of how the students need to conduct the project and their submission pattern, since it was going to be online conduct and submission of the project, different from the normal method.

The College got 47 registrations for the program.

Conduct of the Program

- Annexure 1 – 3 -enrollment list), were sent to the University Department in the second week of January.
- April 20, 2021, the University Department sent a circular to create Annexure for final evaluation.

Projects Undertaken

Student participants opted for the Status of Women in Society (SWS) and Career Project (CP) programs. These projects are alike to co-curricular activities as the students get introduced with to professional usage of computers, research report writing, interviewing people and more.

Orientations

- On January 27, 2021, an Orientation for all the participating students was conducted and they were informed how to go about completing the projects.
- On March 5, 2021, an orientation was conducted for the students to review the progress of work done and guidance on filling the final evaluation report.

Activities

- On March 5, 2021, - ‘Workshop on Calligraphy’ through the Google Meet platform was organized for the DLLE students. This was done with the objective of helping students improve their handwriting which has got relatively affected with the use of digital devices.
- On April 11, 2021, the Department in collaboration with the NSS unit of the College conducted an Awareness and Sensitization Workshop on the lives of the visually challenged. The facilitator, Ganesh Phalke, was a faculty member from the Xavier’s Resource Centre for the Visually Challenged -XRCVC). The workshop was named, ‘Antarchakshu’, meaning ‘the eyes within’ in Sanskrit.

Final Evaluation

This AY due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the evaluation of students was done online by the University Department.

Environmental Studies

The activities conducted by the Department of Environmental Studies during the Academic year are as stated below:

- On July 22, 2020, the Department organized an online Webinar on ‘Butterflies and its life cycle’, for all students, and the Resource person was Ms. Sarita Achrekar, Expert on the subject. About 83 Students participated for the same. The aim of activity was to create awareness about education in ecology and nature conservation.
- On April 6, 2021, the Department organized an Essay writing Competition on “Environmental Pollution & Human Health” for all the students. A total of 58 students participated in the competition. The objective of conducting the activity is to understand the fact of their surrounding pollutants and how to take care of their families.
- On April 10, 2021, Department organized a virtual tour of the Solar Panel which is on the Terrace of the College. 50 students participated in the visit. The aim of the virtual tour was to provide knowledge and information about the working of the solar panel and usage of power of solar energy.
- On May 15, 2021, the Department organized a virtual tour of the Patuck-Green Campus, for all the students. 121 students participated in this wonderful event. Dr. D. S. Mhaske and Prashant Kokane were the Resource Persons for this session and the objectives of conducting the activity was to gain knowledge on the botanical and common names of the various plants and trees on campus and the second was to understand the importance of rainwater harvesting, which was newly created on campus.

Foundation Course

The activities conducted by the Department during the Academic year were:

- On June 11, 2020, the Department organized “Digital Poster Making Competition” on the theme, “Different Dimensions of our National Symbols” for all the students. Total of 14 students participated. The main aim was to enhance the knowledge and understanding of National Symbols of India. Students were allowed to use any applicable digital device to draw the digital paintings.
- On April 11, 2021, the Department organized an Essay writing Competition for all the students. The topic of this competition was “Science & Technology its Impact on Human life”. The main aim of this activity was to help students understand the need to minimize the use of technology in their day-to-day life. 18 participations were received in this activity.
- On May 12, 2021, the Department organized the “Gandhi Vichar Exam” for all the students. This examination introduced the students to the life and message of Gandhiji, through a series of simple and highly readable textbook. Also, the students were made aware of the thoughts of Gandhiji. 128 students participated in the exam.

Internal Complaints Committee

Our College has constituted Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) as per the Guidelines the University of Mumbai. The main objective of this Committee is to create a safe environment for all the women in the College premises and prohibit the sexual harassment in the college Campus.

Activities conducted under ICC

- On August 3, 2020 the Committee conducted an Orientation of ICC for the Second and Third Year students through the Google Meet. It was conducted by the Convenor of the ICC.
- On October 18, 2020 the Committee in Collaboration with Bhartiya Stree Shakti (BSS), an NGO, conducted a Virtual Orientation of ICC for the Teaching and non-teaching staff. It was conducted by Mrs. Seematai Deshpande, President, BSS and Mrs. Manisha Chavan, Member, BSS. The theme of the orientation was 'Sexual Harassment at Workplace - Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act 2013'.
- On October 22, 2020 the Committee in Collaboration with Bhartiya Stree Shakti, conducted an online workshop on Gender Equity Sensitization. It was organized for all the students. The Resource person for the session were Mrs. Ranjana Karroor and Ms. Nootan Varekar, both Members, BSS. The theme of the orientation was, 'Sexual Harassment at Workplace - Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act 2013.

Library Committee

Orientations

- The Committee organized an Orientation on Remote Access of Library E-resources for the Second and Third Year students of B. Com, BMS & B. Com (Banking & Insurance) on June 26, 2020, through the Google Meet platform. Since the lockdown was ongoing it was an attempt to provide study materials to the students. In this the Librarian oriented the students about the e-resources available in the drive and how to access the resources through the link that would be provided to them.
- The Committee organized an Orientation for the First Year students on October 30, 2020, through the Google Meet platform. The Librarian oriented the students about the library collections, facilities, activities, services and rules and regulation. The students were made aware about the remote access of our Library e-resources.
- The Committee organized a demonstration on the use of iOPAC for the Teachers on June 1, 2021, through the online mode. Teachers were shown how to login and find a book, how to send a request for issue, how to send a request for booking a book and more. A similar session was also conducted for the students on May 29, 2021.

Activities Conducted

- *National Level Poetry Writing and Recitation Competition*

The Committee took an initiative to organize an Online National Level Poetry Writing & Recitation Competition, for Teachers and Librarians. The competition permitted entries in three languages, namely, English, Hindi & Marathi. This was organized on August 12, 2020, to commemorate the Birth Anniversary of 'The Father of Library Science - Dr. S. R. Ranganathan'. The Competition was conducted through the Google Meet. All participants clearly recited their poems. There were 25 participants from all over the country, making it truly a national level event. Three judges were appointed for the competition, Dr. Nandita Roy, Principal, Gurukul College of Commerce, for poems in English; Mrs. Suman Singh, Head, Patuck English Medium School, for poems in Hindi and Mr. Uday Desai, Senior Faculty, Patuck Junior College, MCVC Section, for poems in Marathi. The judgment was on the basis of the theme, clarity of content, quality of content, creativity and the overall presentation.

- *Discussion Session on Career Planning & Preparation for Competitive Examination*
Under the MoU with Public Degree Night College, the Committee organized a Discussion Session on, 'Career Planning & Preparation for Competitive Examination' for students of both the colleges on March 4, 2021, through the online mode. Trilokchand Jajoria, in-house Faculty member was the Resource Person. 92 participants attended the session – 45 students were of our College and 47 students were of Public Night Degree College. The objectives to conduct the session were to provide guidance about choosing a career, the different types and levels of competitive examinations available and also the courses available for further studies. The major aim of making the students start planning about their future was to be achieved.

Activities Conducted By NDLI Club in Collaboration with Departments

The aim of conducting collaborative activity was to create awareness among students about the NDLI Club & its valuable E-resources available for reference studies.

- In collaboration with the Department of Business Economics was organized a "Panel Discussion" on October 2, 2020, through the Google meet platform. Six students were the Panelist and 57 students were audience. The topic for discussion was "Foreign Investment in India – Why is it so Important for a Country like India" and the competition was judged by Ms. Megha Nair. To encourage students to deliberate on academic issues, the best speakers among the panelists were rewarded.
- In collaboration with the Department of Management Studies, a Business Planning Competition was held on November 4, 2020, for the students of BMS & B.Com. (B&I) through the Google meet platform. The students accessed the NDLI e-resources, searched for innovative business ideas, prepared a PowerPoint Presentation and presented the same in a group. The presentation was judged by Ms. Megha Nair. The Judge also provided valuable suggestion on how to improve their business planning skills.
- On December 24, 2020, in collaboration with the Department of Business Communication was organized an online activity on "Reading, Writing & Narrating Skills" for the First Year students. They could participate in three languages English, Hindi & Marathi. The activity was organized to provide an opportunity to enhance the skills of the students in reading, writing and narrating. In this activity the participants had read a book, write a summary about that book and on the day of the competition, the students narrated the story of the book. 17 students participated. Krupa Shah and Megha Nair judged the participants on the basis of the reading, writing and narrating

skills and also their overall presentation. The summaries received were chosen for the creation of 'Bibliotherapy' section.

- In collaboration with the Department of Computer was organized an Online Essay Writing Competition on the topic "Online Education" for students on February 28, 2021. The Competition was a home activity where the students wrote and submitted the essays. 23 students participated in the competition. The best essays were judged and the winners were awarded Certificates. The objective of this was to know the students level of understanding about Online Education and how to make the optimum use of the new format of teaching - learning. Entries were permitted in three languages, namely, Hindi, English and Marathi.

Deputing Students

- The Committee received an invitation for the National Webinar on "The 7 Habits of Effective Readers" organized by KES' Shroff College of Arts & Commerce on November 24, 2020, through the online mode. 6 students from our College attended the webinar to understand the difference between readers and effective readers and how to build the habits of effective readers. Mr. Amrut Deshmukh author of the book "The 7 Habits of Effective Readers" was a Resource person for the Webinar. The learnings they derived were:
 - Do not read seriously
 - Read and Pass
 - Read and discuss
 - Read random
 - Reading should be to fill the pocket time
 - Get the great picture
 - Secret habits can be found once you start and develop the reading habit.

Management Studies

The Department conducted many activities in the academic year 2020-21. Despite the lockdown it succeeded in engaging the students in a number of activities and they did not miss being on the field. The activities are conducted through the online mode.

- On July 31, 2020, a PowerPoint competition was conducted where the students participated in large number and showcased their presentation skills. Such activity initiated by the Department encourages students to exhibit their creativity and also provides a platform for them to do the same.
- On August 13, 2020, a Case study Analysis competition was conducted through the Google Meet. The link to the case study was given to the students where students read it and submitted their answers. Such activity organized, is to enhance the analytical skills of the students. Case study is also an important topic in the curriculum of BMS students.
- A Business Planning competition was held on November 4, 2020, in collaboration with the NDLI Club of the Library. Students from T.Y.BMS, S.Y.BMS, S.Y.B.Com.(B&I), participated with very creative and innovative ideas. They portrayed their ideas through a PowerPoint presentation where they have presented group wise. The best idea was judged by Megha Nair. The judge also gave valuable suggestions how to improve their business plan. The Competition was held through the Google Meet.

- On February 1, 2021, an Online Business Quiz was conducted where students were given the link to attempt the questions given through a Google Form.
- On March 20, 2021, a Slogan Making competition was conducted. An activity of this kind encourages students to think independently and have creative ideas.

Mathematics & Statistics

The Department undertook the following activities for the students during the AY

- *Bridge Course in Mathematics*
Most of the students taking admission to the First year would have dropped the Mathematics subject at their XI & XII. Hence, they find it difficult to learn Mathematics at the First Year after a gap of two years. In order to help students with this problem, a bridge course was conducted to provide them with understanding of fundamental concepts in Mathematics. The sessions were conducted before commencement of the regular lectures, during the last week of October 2020, through the Online mode. Over 100 students across B. Com, BMS and B.Com.(B&I) streams joined for the course and around 200 students joined the Google Classroom specially created for uploading relevant study material.
- *Online Maths Quiz Competition*
The Department conducted an online Quiz for students on February 3, 2021. The MCQ format questions were uploaded through a Google Form and the link was made available to students on the WhatsApp class groups. 128 students across all the sections participated in the Quiz.
- *Calendar – Finding Day of the Week*
Students from the First Year were trained to Find the ‘Day of the Week’ for any given date. They were made aware of the technique of finding it through a PowerPoint Presentation. The session was conducted on March 12, 2021, through online mode. 42 students of the First Year were present in this session. At the end of session, students were quizzed to find the day on which were born, and many students could find it successfully.

Mitra Niketan Alumni Association

A plethora of activities were organized by the Association, to maintain a good connect with the Alumni. Below mentioned are the details:

- *Photography Competition*
A Photography Competition among the Alumni was conducted on July 26, 2020. They were provided a theme to make meaningful patterns from vessels at their homes. This was because of the ongoing lockdown, so in order to engage them at home and churn their creative spirit, the activity was done. Their participations comprised of they taking 2-3 vessels, arranging them in a meaningful pattern, clicking a photo of it and mailing it after adding a caption to it. 3 alumni participated and the Committee members judged and declared a winner for the competition. Ms. Ashwini Suvarna, B. Com, 2015- 16 batch, was the winner of the competition.
- *Ganesh Pandal Decoration Competition*

A Ganesh Pandal Decoration Competition for Alumni was organized on August 31, 2020. In this they had to send images of their well decorated Ganesha Pandal at their homes. 7 alumni participated and Netra Thakre and Dr. Tasfiya Shaikh judged the entries on the basis of materials used, creativity and the overall presentation. Three winners were declared and awarded Certificates.

- *Demonstration of Colour Shades*

An Online Demonstration Session on “Colour Shades” was organized on September 5, 2020. Our Alumnus Mr. Chandrashekar Kurmi, B.Com. 2013-14, currently working as Drawing Teacher at Our Lady Good Health High School was invited to conduct the session. 14 students attended the session. Different types of shades of colour were described, they were shown how the combination of colours form various colour shades could be obtained, which colour combination produces what colour. The proportion of colours and how and when to use water to mix the colour and hence get the proper shades for that object was explained.

- *Guest Lecture on “International Trade & Finance Remittances”*

A Guest Lecture on “International Trade & Finance Remittances” was organized on October 2, 2020, through the online mode for the students of all streams. Our alumnus Mr. Karim Khan from B.Com. (B&I) batch, 2013-14 was invited and 77 students attended the lecture. He provided information on International Trade and Finance Remittances and covered various subtopics such as Export, Import, FEMA, Pre & Post Shipment, Letter of Credit, Liberalized, Remittances Scheme, SWIFT& Incoterms. The alumnus also explained how do banks function and its various operational areas, the scope and the job opportunities in the particular field after the completion of Graduation in Commerce, Business Management and Banking & Insurance. Most importantly he emphasized on the need to have good communication skills, confidence and convincing techniques as that he stated is what helps freshers grab good jobs.

- *Webinar on “Women Entrepreneur & Start-Ups”*

- Importance of professional help

- *Closing Meeting of PTA*

PTA conducted the closing meeting with parents for the AY: 2020-21 on May 30, 2021, wherein 86 parents were presented for the meeting to review about the College achievements in curricular, co-curricular as well as extra-curricular activities. The Association members briefed about the new courses launched by the Skill Development Committee for the development of students.

Placement & Career Guidance Cell

The Cell this year continued its association with Technoserve -Ashwattha Advisors Private Limited -AAPL. The institution conducted a Certificate Course on ‘Campus to Corporate’, for the students of the Third year. 49 students were provided training in two batches.

Counselling Sessions Conducted

- “How to Choose a Career After Graduation” --- A webinar with resource person Prof. Rakesh Jain, Director, ISMT B-School, was organized on June 19, 2020. There were 76 student participants across all streams. Monisha D’costa introduced the speaker and the other members of the Cell, Renita Vazirani and Megha Nair also attended the session. The objectives of conducting the session were: a) Giving students an orientation of the wide arena of career options they can choose from being a Commerce, BMS or a B.Com.(B&I) Graduate b) orienting students of the essential processes like entrance exams required for the entry into a career option c) informing them of the components of the entrance exams – broadly what they need to prepare and also d) sources of getting further information about career choices
- Ms. Anu Agrawal, Deputy Director, Western India Regional Council -WIRC of The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India -ICAI, conducted a career counseling session on, April 6, 2021, on the Google meet platform. The session was about undertaking a career in the field of Chartered Accountancy. Twelve students attended the same.

Activities Conducted

- The Cell organized a virtual game on testing “General knowledge of Brands-Logos-Celebrities” through Quizizz App. It is an online pictorial game to identify brands, Logos and Celebrities and timer was self-set by the App, Ranking was on the basis of highest right answers and least time consumed by the player to give the answers. Link for the game was sent across to all the WhatsApp class groups on June 15, 2020 and students were intimated that it will be active only till June 16, 2020. Total of 120 students participated from all the classes in approximately 30 hours duration.
- MS Excel is very important for the students to know at least the basics, as is expected from Corporate, hence an Excel Demo Session by Accountswale was conducted on June 28, 2020 for students. 36 participants attended the session.
- The Principal, Dr. Meeta Pathade and Faculty member, Megha Nair, attended the Certificate Course on ‘Career Guidance and Counselling’, which was conducted in July-August 2020 by the Garware Institute of Career Education & Development, University of Mumbai. This course gave a method and a direction to counsel students for their future career plans after the students are administered a Psychometric test. This was planned to be delivered to the students by the Cell to help students to define their Career Path. Hence the first phase of the plan was to collect data of students who would be interested in being a part of the program and hence on August 30, 2020, a Google Form was rolled out. During the first and second week of September 2020, the Cell circulated the questionnaire among all students to understand their post-graduation education plan and also their career plan. This was done with the objective of systematically counseling students towards their goals, but by first understanding their needs and to a good extent customizing what we provide as career guidance and

placement assistance. The Cell thought it appropriate to develop in students a sense of responsibility of their future right from the first year itself.

- On September 6, 2020, the Cell organized a session on, 'Transportation Model' conducted by IBS, Mumbai. This was to orient the students about careers in Management Studies. 15 students from T.Y.BMS and T. Y. B. Com. (B&I) classes participated in the same
- Resume writing session was organized by the Cell on January 30, 2021, in which 34 students across all programs participated. Students were explained the format of a Resume and were even shown online how to search for readymade templates to prepare their Resume.

Internship Initiatives

- There was an offer from Times Group for Internship offers for the students, and hence the names of interested students were collected in August 2020. Five students from a lot of 15 who applied from our College were shortlisted, as they suited to their eligibilities.
- Despite the lockdown, the Cell received internship offers from the Zoroastrian Bank and the ICAI. Google form was circulated among the students of the First and Second years. They were asked to prepare their Resume. The Cell members interviewed the students, while guiding them how to appear and answer the questions asked by the panelists and also checking and correcting their Resume. Interviews were conducted on April 28-29, 2021. Shortlisted students were sent to Zoroastrian Bank for their final interview.

Research & Publication Cell

The Cell continued its research contributions this year with the involvement of students and the academic staff. *Its yearly practice of publishing its **Insight Management Review**- the Annual ISSN peer-reviewed Research Journal; **Prasuvidha** - the Annual Research Journal for Students; the **Monthly Student Bulletin Board**; **Quarterly E-Newsletters**, **Case Study Bank**, **Monograph Series** was completed on a timely basis.*

Research Achievements

- The Cell organized a National Level Research Colloquium for Students on November 21, 2020. The Colloquium received 12 Research Paper Presenters from various Colleges in Maharashtra and also other states like Kerala. The theme of the Colloquium was, 'Student's Perspective on Contributions of Stakeholders: Society, Government, Teachers & Corporate. Dr. Harshini Shashi, Academician, Bengaluru, was invited to Judge the papers and their presentations at the Colloquium and Dr. Umesh U., Assistant Professor (Research Supervisor), Department of Commerce & Management Studies, Amal College of Advanced Studies, Kerala, was invited to be the Keynote Speaker at the event.
- Ekta Foundation, NGO, has provided monetary sponsorship to the research project on, 'Communication and Ecological Sustenance' proposed by Dr. Chandan Mishra, Faculty Member, Department of Business Communication.

Activities Conducted

- A project needs to be completed by all T.Y.BMS and T. Y. B. Com. (B&I) students as a part of their completion of their Graduation degree and hence the Cell conducted Project guidance lecture for the students on June 17 & 18, 2020 respectively. As the projects have the format of a research report and it involves primary and secondary study, the Cell found it befitting to guide the students. 30 TYBMS students and 32 TYB.Com.(B&I) students participated in the sessions.
- A Mini Biography Writing competition was organized on July 30, 2020, in order to make the students research about business personalities and also social entrepreneurs. This was done with the objective of understanding the various opportunities available to the students in the Corporate world. 14 students participated for the competition.
- The Cell organized a Quiz on August 18, 2020, on Ancient Moral Values. These values have been lost with the advent of technology and the modernity that has set in the Indian society, and hence it was important to make the students browse through them and hence a quiz on the same was organized. 69 students participated for the quiz competition.
- On December 8, 2020, Dr. Kuldeep Sharma, Co-ordinator, M. Phil & Doctoral Programs, K. P. B. Hinduja College of Commerce, was invited to deliver a Seminar on, “Essentials in Research Method To Write Research Paper For Quality Journals”.
- Snapchat Lens Studio Workshop was organized by the Cell on January 24, 2021 through the online platform (Google Meet). 21 students participated in it. Snapchat had upgraded their versions and was creating awareness about the various digital options available on the App.
- The Cell has a Student Bulletin Board, which comprises of articles with high academic value. The bulletin is uploaded on the College website for good read of the students. On February 5, 2021, the Cell conducted a Quiz based on the articles. This was through a Google Form and 66 students responded to the same.

Skill Development Committee

The Committee is for the improvement of students’ skills.

- The Committee organized an Inter-collegiate Student Webinar on the topic "How to improve your Interviewee Skills” on June 22, 2020. The activity was conducted through Google Meet. The resource person for the same was Ms. Shikha Kotian, Senior HR, SNEHA Foundation. It is imperative in today's world, while entering the corporate sector that students are armed with the knowledge on how to tackle an interview with proper etiquettes and confidence. The aim of conducting this activity was to impart information on how to face a job interview with elegance. To know what questions can be asked and how are they supposed to answer and to groom and prepare them with proper etiquettes and dress code required for the same. The activity saw a total of 90 participants who participated from various colleges across Mumbai. All participants were awarded with Certificates. students have given a very positive feedback for the workshop stating that they thoroughly enjoyed the session and found it highly informative and practical. The Committee received multiple requests to conduct such sessions again.

- The Skill Development Committee organized an Online Faculty Development Program on June 23-24, 2020. The FDP was conducted in collaboration with Bombay Stock Exchange.

The topics were as follows:

- FII vs Mutual Funds — Which one back the Indian Markets?
- How COVID- 19 changes the outlook for economy and stock market?

The Google meet link was shared with everyone by the IT Department on June 22, 2020. Mr. Aditya Srinivas was the resource person for both days. He is the Chief Financial Officer of Bombay Exchange.

- On Day 1. Mr. Srinivas spoke about the difference between Foreign Institutional Investment and Mutual kinds and how they affect our Indian Markets and the Economy as a whole. He also pointed out the importance of citizens and their investments in the functioning of our Economy. He implored all of us to invest and invest wisely.
- On Day 2. He spoke about the various investment options available for citizens. He presented the Indian Financial Scenario before COVID, during COVID and what can be possibility after COVID. He educated people about the various investment routes one can choose to expand their current wealth by expanding their portfolio. He also gave advice on which companies are good to invest in and what are the factors one must take into consideration before investing in an organization. Overall, the program was a success. The Committee received an immensely positive feedback for the same. Certificates were distributed to all the participants.
- The Skill Development Committee organized an Online Calligraphy Competition from July 29, 2020, to August 5, 2020. The activity was conducted as a home activity where students were provided with quotes which they had to write down on paper using calligraphy, click a picture and mail it. The aim of conducting this activity was to give students an opportunity to explore their creative handwriting skills. The activity saw a total of 03 participants only. Unfortunately, the team could not decide on the winners as the students had not submitted their entries in the proper format.
- The Skill Development Committee organized an Online Quiz on October 19, 2020, on the topic "Presentation Skills". The activity was conducted through Google Forms where a total of 10 questions were asked. It is imperative in today's world, while entering the corporate sector that students are armed with the basic computer skills such as Excel, PowerPoint, Word etc. It is widely known that even though many do know how to prepare a presentation, not many are aware the finer nuances of being an able presenter. The aim of conducting this activity was to test the knowledge of the students on the minute and finer aspects to be imbibed while presenting in front of an audience. The activity saw a total of 34 participants who have answered the various questions posed to them.

Online Essay-writing Competition and Online Quiz Competition on Indian Constitution Day (25th November, 2020)

The NSS unit conducted an online essay-writing competition and online quiz competition on Indian Constitution Day on 25th November 2020. 10 volunteers participated in the essay-writing activity and 36 volunteers participated in the online quiz competition. The aim of the activities was to make the students aware about the importance of Indian constitution.

Gardening in College Campus (27th November, 2020 to 30th November, 2020)

Gardening activity was conducted in the College campus from 27th November 2020 to 30th November 2020. 20 NSS volunteers helped the gardener in gardening activity behind the school building. This “*Shramadaan*” activity was done by the NSS volunteers

Paper Bag-making & Distribution (30th October, 2020 & 22nd January, 2021)

Paper bag-making and distribution was the initiative taken by our NSS volunteers. The NSS volunteers made paper bags and distributed the same to the local vendors of Vakola. The aim of this activity was to create awareness among the local vendors and the people in the society to avoid use of plastic bags and to promote the use of paper bags as they are environment friendly. 52 NSS volunteers took part in the event.

Nursery Gardening (1st December, 2020 & 2nd February, 2021)
