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



### Counselling And Guidance Cell

• Debate Competition on 'Mental Gym v/s Physical Gym': Counselling & Guidance Cell organized a Debate Competition on 'Mental Gym v/s Physical Gym' on 30th July, 2022 for the students of B.Com./BMS/B.Com (B&I). 17 students participated in the competition. The competition was to know the level of understanding and create awareness about the proper wellness of both physical & mental health. The students actively participated and expressed their views, thoughts and understanding about the physical gym and mental gym.

For further awareness, the counsellor interacted with the students and assisted them to understand the importance and the impact of both Physical & mental gym on our healthy living.

• Developmental Counselling Programme for female students: Our College Counselling & Guidance Cell in collaboration with Department of Applied Psychology & Counselling Centre, University of Mumbai conducted four days program on "Developmental Counselling Programme for female students" of our College on 12th, 14th, 16th & 17th September, 2022. 58 students attended this programme.

#### The main aim of the programme was

- 1. To assist the students on how to focus on their career and personal development.
- 2. To encourage developing special abilities and right attitudes towards successful future.
- 3. To focus on the general well being of young women and helping them to develop skills to deal with gender based aspects.
- 4. To develop overall mental health support for female students.

## The students got the understanding on how to:

- a) Introspect self-awareness to understand opportunities
- b) Strengthen the skills and how to overcome personal, academic and relationship obstacles.
- c) Identify the impact of gender roles and functions that had on their lives, effects of traumas and expectations surrounding the same and strengthening their identity as females.

The programme was well appreciated and received positive feedback from the students.

The workshop was interactive and holistic and greatly beneficial to the teachers.
- Workshop on Parenting Skills: Parent Teacher Association and Counselling & Guidance Cell had organized a Workshop on "Parenting Skills" for parents on 17th December, 2022.

Counsellors, Mr. Prasanna Jadhav & Ms. Neha Gudur conducted the workshop to make parents understand the on-going changes and challenges children undergo and the need of family support while attempting to comprehend how the world functions; to assist parents on understanding and sympathizing the viewpoint of their adolescent children; necessity of communicating with their children and to interpret about mental, physical, social, digital health and addiction. Parents were pleased with the workshop and accepted the essentialness of Understanding and Communicating to deal with the situation to develop healthy relation among their children. They were happy to know about the free facility of Professional Counselling which can be accessed with prior appointments not only available to parents but also to the students so as to re-develop better environment for adolescence.

- Orientation on Ethical Practices in Exams: Unfair Means Inquiry Committee and Counselling & Guidance Cell had taken an initiative to conduct an Orientation on "Ethical Practices in Exams" for all students of B.Com, BMS & B.Com. (B&I). 313 students were oriented. Mr. Prasanna Jadhav, Assistant Counsellor visited the classrooms to orient students about the cons of Unfair Means at the time of examinations on scheduled days from 19th to 23rd December, 2022. The program was not only to educate students who have indulged in the use of unfair means but also to prevent others from doing so. The orientation gave a clear picture of their own actions to get involved in using unfair means and its consequences. They got an understanding not only in the context of the use of unfair means but also in the context of managing stress during exam time. At the end, the students had raised their concerns and the expectations of their families with the Asst. Counsellor and the issues were addressed by providing them with a few suggestions to manage these pressures.
- Awareness Campaign on Exam Anxiety: Unfair Means Inquiry Committee and Counselling & Guidance Cell had taken the initiative to conduct an AwarenessCampaign on Exam Anxiety" for all students of F.Y.B.Com, F.Y.BMS & F.Y.B.Com. (B&I) in their respective classrooms. 122 students benefitted from the campaign. Mr. Prasanna Jadhav, Assistant Counsellor visited the classrooms to orient students about the assumptions of high exam anxiety. He briefed that anxiety not only affects the preparations for the exam but also in turn triggers students to engage in using unfair means during the exam. Therefore, the campaign was structured in a way that will be helpful to all the students for understanding the adaptive value of exam anxiety, learn about the indicators of exam anxiety and understanding reasons that elevates exam anxiety. The main focus was on helping them understand certain easy-to-implement strategies in their daily routine. Strategies were prescribed according to the available time before exam (ex. what can be done weeks before the exam, a day before the exam etc.). This made the campaign holistic and comprehensive.

#### Cultural Committee

The College has an energetic Cultural Committee that provides a platform for students to showcase their talent.
