> Awareness Campaign on Ban on Plastics (25th July, 2022)



Campus Cleaning Drive (Sept 2022 To Feb, 2023)


Campus cleaning activity was conducted in the College campus. The aim of the activity was to promote the value of cleanliness among the students and to beautify the environment.

NSS Rural Residential Camp

Venue – At post - Manivali Village, Tehsil- Kalyan, District- Thane

Date – 20th December 2022 to 26th December 2022

A total of 77 volunteers attended the camp along with 03 Program Officers.

▶ Day 1: 20th December 2022

The NSS PO with along with the other teachers conducted a meeting with the Volunteers and gave instructions regarding their duties, daily activities, code of conduct, etc. On the first day the students were divided into six groups and were allotted the duties of Cleanliness, Kitchen, and rest were allocated with other duties. The duties were performed by the Volunteers on rotational basis. Cleanliness drive was conducted on the first day and students enthusiastically participated in the same. In the evening after a tea break, the students were given time to prepare for the entertainment program. The entertainment program gave a real boost to the hidden talent of the students.

▶ Day 2: 21st December 2022

One group was allocated the responsibility of cleanliness at the venue. The second group was allocated the responsibility to help the Cook in the Kitchen and all the related activities. The other four groups conducted a survey to find the availability of water pipeline in each and every household. The students also taught the school children and made teaching aids for them.

On 22nd December 2022, Mr. Bajrang sir taught the students the art of drama and gave them social topics to enact and conduct street plays for creating awareness among the people regarding various social evils of the society. Students did street plays on various issues of society such as Dowry, Eve Teasing, Killing of Girl Child, Female abuse, Honor Killing and so on. It was indeed a great learning experience for the students.

▶ Day 4: 23rd December 2022

We conducted Haldi Kumkum ceremony for the Ladies of the village. On that occasion, one of our Faculty Member, Mrs. Netra Thakre delivered a session for the rural women on the rights given to the women by the Constitution of our nation. Dr. Pallav Das was also a part of the event. Women enthusiastically participated in the *Haldi Kumkun* ceremony.

Day 5: 24th December 2022

On 24th December we conducted health check-up and eye check-up Camp for the residents. It was a successful event as huge number of villagers availed the benefits of the health check-up and eye check-up camp. We distributed 80 spectacles free of cost to the first 80 people who checked their eyes. Dr. Tasfiya Patel added the feather in the cap with her presence and it helped us for the smooth conduct of the medical camp. In the evening, Mr. Rajan sir conducted an entertainment session for the students where the students learnt various values through fun activities.

▶ Day 6: 25th December 2022

On 25th December we took the students for a field visit at nearby places to make them cherish the beauty of nature. We also visited Vishwas Rao farm which is an Agro tourism spot in Manivali Village.
