JUNE 2026

- **World Environment Day**

On **5th June 2026**, students of the Commerce Section actively participated in activities promoting environmental awareness. 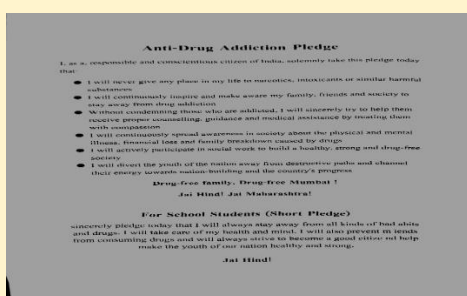
- **Guru Purnima Celebration**

performance was warmly appreciated by teachers, parents, and peers, making the event memorable and inspiring for all present.



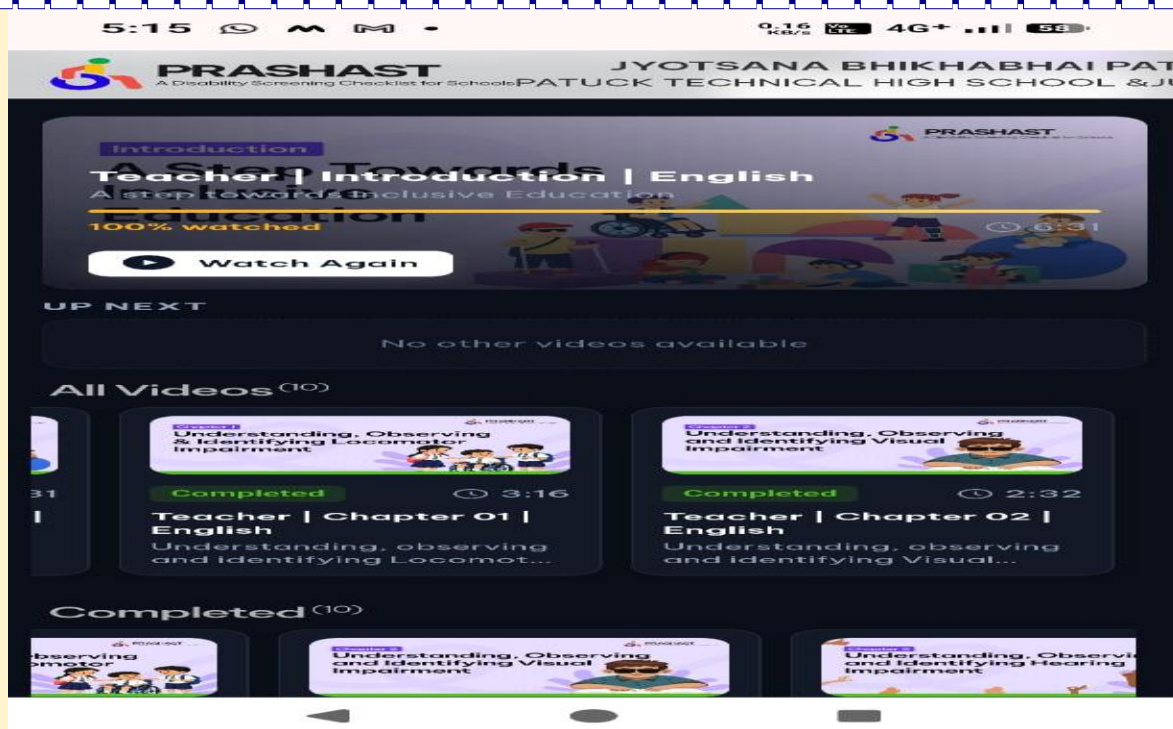
- **POCSO Awareness Session – Std. XI & XII**

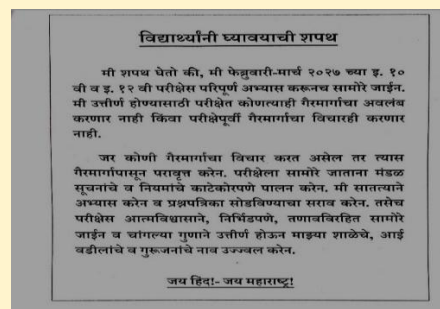
- **PTA Meeting – Std. XI**

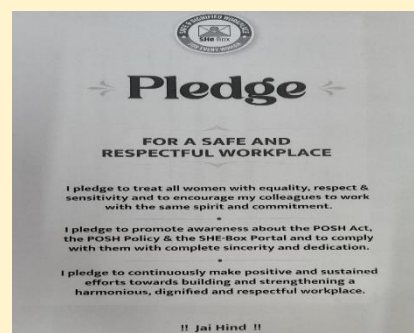
- **Copy Mukta Pledge**
